SRC 6th D. Mr. Nalley came in about his road-complains that when it is dragged or scraped makes the road very bad. He was advised the 30ft road will only be maintained-if he can get 40ft R/W new road will be built. He had to buy several acres in order to get the 30ft R/W and not willing to buy more.
