Nicolet Park-Lex, Pk.

Mrs Nicolet who is sec-treas of the Nicolet Park Asso., asked permission to erect a small building (either frame or cinder block according to amount of contributions the Association receives) to keep base balls and bats, gloves, etc. and also to have septic tank installed and 2 outdoor toilets erected. Commissioners agreed this could be done providing at no expense to the County. Permission was also requested to have stand where Scouts could sell soft drinks, candy etc. No license needed unless alcoholic beverages are sold.

Camp Saysf Road- deed to County in 1945- GBG 20-folio 400 11-14-45 Road is narrow winding and dangerous. People who use road and attend Camp would like to have it repaired.

Thomas Berry, Hollywood came in again about decision of Commissioners about his road. After inspection by Mr. Alvey and Mr. Bond they decided it is not a County road matter and Berry should see a lawyer about the closing of the roadway by Miedzinski.

Dr Houser came in to report that the Medical Care Committee of the State Planning Commission is recommending a Bill whereby the expenses of a Nursing Home built by any County for State use, will be divided so that the County will pay about \$10,000 for a \$100,000 building, or 20% of 50% of the actual cost. He feels this will pass, and become effective about July 59-or 60.
