When all members of the Board and their attorney met today it was decided to request Jackson Haley of Mechanicsville to fill the vacancy left on Welfare Board by resignation of Fr. Linehan. Letter was written to Mr. Jackson *Haley*.

Letter to Ed Whalen, Charlotte Hall, advising that R/W must be 40 ft. wide, not 30 ft as heretofore required. Bd. of Directors of Charlotte Hall must deed part of this R/W as road runs along their property.

Comptroller sent check for Somerset County here for \$7,408.19 in error. CGF check #6346 for this amount was sent to Comptroller.

Letter from Supervisors of Election asking that salary of clerk be increased to \$1200.00 per year No provisions in Budget for this increase.

St. Mary's Advertising-Development Co advised their Budget is \$3,000 for 58-59 and must keep within that amount.

Colored County Agent *was* advised *that* all necessary equipment etc., must be secured thru this office.

Roads 3D Richardson Road, accepted in 56, needs repairs now. Mr. Cusic was present and agreed to look over road and see what was necessary and report at next meeting.

Dr. Foster, Univ. of Md. Mos. Control came in to settle accounts for 57-58 Auditor Lipski will assist in this.

Trial Magistrate J. Walter Abell came in to ask for additional clerical help; work in his office and that of the Sheriff has increased a great deal and detail work requires extra time. Board will consider this. Applicants Audrey Burroughs, Jean Hayden and Shirley Rock- salary will be \$100 mo less wht and so sec
