

September 17, 1958

All the Commissioners and their attorney were present at today's regular meeting.

Parochial school transportation:- Rev. James Wilkinson, SJ, pastor of Holy Face, and director of transportation for parochial schools in the County, came in with Redman and Jos. Bean and Paul Bell, in an attempt to clear up the overloading of busses at Little Flower school. After a lengthy discussion it was decided that Paul Bell should secure another large bus and this would relieve the situation.

Mrs. Maxwell of Town Creek asked that sign limiting travel to 25 MPH be placed on road near very ganderous curve, also sign "Children-Slow" be also placed on the road where 12 children wait daily for the school bus. It was explained that the Commissioners would have to purchase the signs and the SRC would erect them.

Mr. John Healy, clerk to Supervisors of Elections, asked that telephone be installed in his office in the Court House. During the primaries many calls came in, but since that office is only in use twice in each election year- or every two years- no phone had been installed. One is now installed on a buzzer system which is connected with the County Commissioners' office. Installation charge \$7.00 monthly charge \$1.90

1 mi additional extension was added to Frank Ellis' route  
8 mi were added to G. Alex Hebb's route-

Beachwood Drive-Town Creek- to be accepted by Commissioners for maintenance only. Mr. Capps will send in plats and have DEED recorded.

Road in Town Creek to be completed in near future. Messrs. Koegel, Swaney and Hammond came in about this and asked to see plans for new school to be built there. This is a Public school and they were directed to Mr. King's office.

St. Andrew Ch road-extended to Bensonwood Dr. Mr. Bond had inspected this road and advised the Commissioners it was not up to specifications, some more work is needed and County agreed to put in crosspipes and accept road for Maintenance only Atty W.M. Loker, Jr has DEED and plats which Mr. Torrey will secure from him and have same recorded.

Dr. Houser came in to talk about a sanitarian to be assigned to making percolation tests only. He is to set his fee -if only one test to be made in a section he could charge more than if several tests were made in same area at same time. State Health Law requires that such tests be made for all lots where buildings will have plumbing. FHA requires this before they will approve loan. Board will consider the matter and advise Dr. Houser.

State Fire Marshall Lloyd Britt with County Fire Marshal Smith came in about installation of fire extinguishers in County owned buildings. These extinguishers are required by law, and State Fire Marshal sent in a list of those necessary for all County buildings.

Amount for Road Maintenance for 59 is \$214,000.00
