All members and their attorney were present today.

Fr. Burton, S.J. and members of the PFA of Sacred Heart School- Mrs. L. Howe, Mr. and Mrs. Norris; Mr. Andy Kucher; Bill Hammett and Driver George Lacey, came in about overcrowded busses and asked permission to reroute the bus. One 60 passenger bus carries 80-50 children on one trip and the 2nd trip carries 23 permission was granted to reroute this bus. Mr. Lacey complained of the entrance into Notley Hall- the turn is on the hill and is very dangerous especially in winter Cars coming down the hill cannot see the bus until almost too late There could be a sign placed above the turn

Dr. Couser requested a Board of Health meeting to have the Commissioners adopt a measure whereby no Building Permits would be issued in this office until the Health Dept issued a certification that the site was adaptable for proper sewage and water disposal. Commissioners were asked to prepare and enforce an Administrative Decree

Bids on painting in Health Dept and exterior received from Jarrett Speith \$669 and Phil Davis \$665- none from Cass or Weiland. contract not awarded

Clerk asked to have desk moved from office of Civil Defense to Sheriff's office. This was done.

Mr. John Hodges, newly elected County Commissioner was invited to attend the first discussion of the proposed 59-60 Budget on Tues. Nov 25, at 2:30 pm

Mr. James Waring came in again at the storm sewer at Hancock and Midway Drive, Patuxent Park- Mr. Duncan, Mr. Webb and Mr. Bond were present at this time Mr. Duncan agreed pipe could be enlarged at this intersection to 12 inches to relieve conditions. He also said they should use adequate pipe for this and Mr. Bond is to investigate and determine just what is causing the trouble.
