Mr. Bowles, Clerk, Liquor Board asked for legal size metal cabinet for papers in various cases. Lawrence Hayden asked for his Dec salary check- he was informed the former Clerk to the Liq. Bd failed to notify the Commissioners of the change in Inspectors, Hayden taking Love's place, and Love received the Dec check. He was advised to contact J.B.Love for this money.

Sheriff\* advised he must OK all bills for mileage, meals etc., before sending them to this office.

Roads- Mr. Bond was requested to furnish a list of all County employees in the SRC work, with their classification and salaries.

Engineer Lutz, Don Garner and Mr. Tilp will be in Wed-Feb 4 to inspect the furnace and locate the cause of lack of heat.

After Feb 15, Mr. Tilp will contact Mr. Dean, contractor, to endeavor to have Mr. Dean complete the many minor details left undone on his contract.

Meeting held between Trailer Park owners and Trailer salesmen, present were Messrs. Ackerman, Hall, Hill, Hood, Millison, Davis and Painter, with Dr. Locke and Mr. Hartwell also here. Lengthy discussion followed- a second meeting will be held in the near future to work out Parking space fee.

Insurance companies holding policies on County owned property and machinery were asked to send in list of such policies. Waring & Son, Frank A. Combs, John Drury, Allston & Trossbach.
