

February 24, 1959

All commissioners and their attorney met in regular session today.

Dr. Houser came in about salary increases for the Sanitariums becoming due Mar 1, not May 1. When questioned about salary of Mr. Hartwell he informed the Board that the State Health Dept requires all sanitarians to be paid a like salary. Increase in expense account of Dr. Houser to be considered.

State Tax Commission advised Mr. Abell Center Gardens must be kept on the Tax Books, even tho taxes cannot be collected from the property owners.

Commissioners adopted Resolution to borrow \$100,000.00. Resolution was introduced by Mr. Guy and seconded by Messrs Alvey and Hodges, effective Feb 24-1959 from National Central Bank of Balto. See Resolution attached hereto. Check to be deposited in CGF #1- 1st Nat Bank-Leonardtown

Insurance agencies holding policies on County owned property and accident insurance requested send in list of such policies. Lists received from Drury and Son, Frank A. Combs

Discussed Lucy Dorsey's contract, whether or not she can just turn it over to another party. No decision

Mr. J.H.T. Briscoe with a group of taxpayers from the 8th D came in about a different Fire Tax than the one which recently became effective. They feel this law should be repealed and a more equitable one set up. Lengthy discussion followed. Mr. Briscoe will prepare a petition to be signed by the taxpayers and sent to the Delegates asking that the law be changed, and new legislation with uniform taxation be enacted. The group was composed of Mr. and Mrs. Geo Thompson, Messrs Swinson, Geo. Hammett, Frank Hayden, Mr and Mrs A. Robideaux, Mrs. Wm. Bwman, Mrs. M. Nocilet. All above agree that new legislation is necessary

Mr. Archie Meatyard came in about the Tax Bills sent to Mr. Juenemann, regarding streets in T.T. sub-division. Streets were never deeded to the County altho the road dividing waterfront from rear lots has been. Mr. Meatyard and Mr. Sterling will prepare a plan for this matter and submit it to the Commissioners.

Mrs. Mabel S. Ingalls has given Mr. Briscoe permission to have survey made for the road in Sotterley which will connect with the County road.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in order to defray necessary and proper expenses for the operation of the County Government until June 30, 1959, the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County, Maryland, must borrow the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$150,000.00) Dollars under the power and authority granted it by Senate Bill No. 140 duly enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland Session of 1959, same being designated as Chapter 40 of the Laws of Maryland 1959 Session, and, WHEREAS, it has been determined by the said County Commissioners to borrow from the National Central Bank of Baltimore the sum of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars, which is to be repaid with interest at the rate of four per centum (4%) per annum from date said sum is borrowed in the following manner, that is to say: the sum of Thirty Three Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Three Dollars and Thirty-Four Cents (\$33,333.34) and interest at the rate aforesaid accruing on said principal sum are to be paid on or before August 1, 1959, and thereafter interest at the rate aforesaid on the unpaid principal sum is to be paid semi-annually, and the sum of Thirty Three Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Three Dollars and Thirty-Four Cents (\$33,333.34) on said principal sum is to be paid on the first day of August, 1960, and the sum of Thirty Three Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Three Dollars and Thirty-Two Cents on said principal sum is to be paid on the first day of August, 1961, and to borrow from The First National Bank of St. Mary's at Leonardtown the sum of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars, which is to be paid with interest at the rate of four per centum (4%) per annum from date said sum is borrowed in the following manner, that is to say: the sum of Sixteen Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Six Dollars and Sixty-Six Cents (\$16,666.66) and interest accruing on said principal sum are to be paid on or before August 1, 1959, and thereafter interest at the rate aforesaid on the unpaid principal sum is to be paid semi-annually, and the sum of Sixteen Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Six Dollars and Sixty-Six Cents (\$16,666.66) on said principal sum is to be paid on the first day of August, 1960, and the

sum of Sixteen Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Six Dollars and Sixty Eight Cents on said principal sum is to be paid on the first day of August, 1961, and, WHEREAS, it has been determined by said County Commissioners to issue its two promissory notes upon the faith and credit of St. Mary's County executed on behalf of said County Commissioners by its President and by its Clerk and bearing its corporate seal, one to the order of the said Central National Bank of Baltimore in the principal sum of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars, payable with interest and in the manner aforesaid, and the other to the order of The First National Bank of St. Mary's at Leonardtown in the principal sum of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars, payable with interest and in the manner aforesaid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County, in regular meeting assembled, this 24th day of February, 1959, that said County Commissioners borrow upon the faith and credit of St. Mary's County from the National Central Bank of Baltimore the principal sum of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars, which is to be repaid with interest at the rate of four per centum (4%) per annum from date said sum is borrowed in the following manner, that is to say: the sum of Thirty Three Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Three Dollars and Thirty-Four Cents (\$33,333.34) and interest accruing on said principal sum are to be paid on or before August 1st, 1959, and thereafter interest at the rate aforesaid on the unpaid principal sum is to be paid semi-annually, and the sum of Thirty Three Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Three Dollars and Thirty-Four Cents (\$33,333.34) on said principal sum is to be paid on the first day of August, 1960, and the sum of Thirty Three Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Three Dollars and Thirty Two Cents (\$33,333.32) ^{on said principal sum} is to be paid on the first day of August, 1961, and from The First National Bank of St. Mary's at Leonardtown the principal sum of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars which is to be paid with

interest at the rate of four per centum (4%) per annum from date said sum is borrowed in the following manner, that is to say: the sum of Sixteen Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Six Dollars and Sixty Six Cents (\$16,666.66) and interest accruing on said principal sum is to be paid on or before August 1, 1959, and thereafter interest at the rate aforesaid on the unpaid principal sum is to be paid semi-annually, and the sum of Sixteen Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Six Dollars and Sixty Six Cents (\$16,666.66) on said principal sum is to be paid on the first day of August, 1960, and the sum of Sixteen Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Six Dollars and Sixty Eight Cents (\$16,666.68) on said principal sum is to be paid on the first day of August, 1961; said principal sums to be evidenced by the two promissory notes, one to the order of the National Central Bank of Baltimore in the principal sum of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars, payable with interest and in the manner aforesaid, and the other to the order of The First National Bank of St. Mary's at Leonardtown in the principal sum of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars, payable with interest and in the manner aforesaid, said notes to be executed on behalf of the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County, Maryland, by Leonard S. Alvey, its President, and by Sara M. King, its Clerk, bearing its Corporate Seal.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforesaid monies are to be borrowed and this Resolution is passed pursuant to the power and authority granted to the said County Commissioners by Senate Bill No. 140 duly enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland Session of 1959, same being designated as Chapter 40 of the Laws of Maryland 1959 Session.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective as of the date of its passage.

CHAPTER NO.....

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT to authorize the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's County to borrow a certain sum of money and relating generally to the amount and to the time, manner, procedure, rate of interest and repayment of any such borrowed monies and the use of the proceeds thereof.

1 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,*
2 That the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's County is
3 authorized and empowered to borrow up to but not exceeding the
4 sum of \$200,000.00 in order to defray necessary and proper expenses
5 for the operation of the County government during the period be-
6 tween the effective date of this Act and June 30, 1959, inclusive. Any
7 amount so borrowed shall be evidenced by notes, bonds or other
8 certificates of indebtedness issued upon the faith and credit of St.
9 Mary's County. The time, manner, procedure, rate of interest and
10 repayment of any such bonds, notes or other certificates of indebted-
11 ness shall be as determined by resolution of the Board of County
12 Commissioners of St. Mary's County.

1 SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Section is hereby
2 declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the imme-
3 diate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been
4 passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of the
5 members elected to each of the two houses of the General Assembly,
6 the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.
