The Commissioners and their attorney met in regular session today.

Dale Cropper came in about having lights installed at entrance to Town Creek subdivision. Mr. Hodges will meet with Mr. Beck of REA, to check area and ascertain how many and at what cost lights can be installed in that area.

Board approved appointment of Dr Roy Guyther as member of Welfare Bd. Judge Waxter so notified.

Letter to SRC asking for survey and report on necessity of lights at intersection of SR#235 and Shangri-La Drive, SR#235 and Town Creek Dr also at Great Mills Rd and Shangri-La Drive. *Cove Rd.*

Shrf. Miedzinski with Deputy Sanger came in to ask that increase be allowed in expense account of deputies from 1200 to 2,000 per year. This will be taken under consideration. Sheriff was authorized to purchase caps and badges needed for force. Markers to be placed on deputies cars discussed but found not practical.

Lt. Cmdr. Goodman, 503 Franklin Drive, Statuxent Park came in about procedure for having Franklin Rd accepted by County for maintenance. Mr. Bond will inspect the road on Wed. Mar 11 and ascertain what is needed to bring it up to SRC specifications. Commissiones will then write advising owners of property on this road what is needed and cost for same, and that they will, on completion and approved inspection, accept the road. Mr. Randolph reported that he had been requested to make survey of material needed and advise them of cost of putting road into acceptable condition.

SRC- Mr. Bond informed the Board that the following roads had been placed on the Secondary Rd list for Fed. aid- Snow Hill- Stevens(Hermanville) Vista Rd Twm Creek Rd 7 Gables- Horsehead and St Andrews Ch roads for reconstruction & Fed aid.

S Sprigg Reeves, with Cecelia Butler of Oakville, came in about the road to his farm which is used by 5 families and his tenant- in very bad condition he asked that it be repaired. Mr. Alvey with Mr. Bond will inspect the road and see what can be done and report later.

Mr. Tilp came in to report that Mr. M. M. Dean had finally agreed to complete Court House project. They will be in Wed Mar 18

Group of owners and operators of Trailer Camps and Sales agencies appeared at 2:30 to discuss bill to be presented to Gen Assembly relative to fees for trailers and trailer parks etc. Mr. Hodges made several suggestions as to fees for individual trailers, parks etc., these were discussed at length. Commissioners will meet in Annapolis with County legislators on Wed Mar 11 on this matter
