

March 17, 1959

The Commissioners and their attorney met in regular session today.

Mr. Robt. King, Bd. of Education requested that letters be written to Sen. Glenn Beall, Sen. John Butler and Rep Richard Lankford, USMC, asking for appropriate action to sevice funds from Fed. Gov. to reimburse school districts under Public Law 874. This was done. Copy of letter is attached hereto.

Dr. Houser, Dr. Locke and K.B. Duke Sr., appeared relative to cleaning up the unsightly spots used by the public for dumping trash etc. A lengthy discussion was had and Mr. Duke was authorized to look into the matter of securing sites for Public dumps. Moakley Mattingly Sr is interested in hauling trash from roads etc. to a central site allocated by the Commissioners. Mr. Duke will contact members of the Natl. Guard and the Vol. Fire Depts in an effort to have them burn over the places and use their equipment to push the refuse into dumps already in use. Commissioners will ask Mr. McMullen of SRC for use of their equipment in cleaning up the roads. The report was that the entire County is in a deplorable state from trash along the highways.

Mr. Martin of the C & P Telephone came in to explain about using the PBX system which has been partially installed in the Court House. He feels outside lines now installed to office of Sheriff and State Police should not be touched. The PBX system will require about half the numbers the County now has, but the same number of lines. Full time operator will cost about \$175 per mo and some one in the Court House will be instructed to act as relief operator and trained for the work. Present cost is about \$300 per mo. Cost of each separate line will be \$5 and each extension \$5. The operator will act as Information Bureau. Mr. Martin will present a complete survey to the Board and decision will be made.

St Mary's Co Library sent in request for $\frac{1}{2}$ of their 1958-59 budget \$7943.86 Bd. of Education asked for A-J payment also Fire Depts asked for their allotment All advised payments will be made in May.

Roads- Mrs. Maude Gardiner asked that something be done to the ^{drainage problem -} rd above Yowaiski's Mill Mr. Bond advised her that within 2 weeks ^{this} road will be ~~graded and bulldozed.~~ ^{attended to.}

SRC was requested to close Old Willows Rd from rear of Phil Gray enterprises and Methodist church to intersection with New Willows Rd as road is in very dangerous condition.

Mr J.T. Waring came in again about SRC storm sewers and those of Patuxent Park asks that SRC use wire snake to clean out their lines.

Copy of letter from Md. State Agency for Surplus Property-Piney Pt- was sent to Sen. Dorsey and Delegates Fowler and Combs.

Alice Howard-Geo. Dedderrer et al Rd, 3 plats given to SRC. CBG 69 folio 392

Mr. Ralph Abell and Wm. Herbert came in about the additional appointment to their office- discussion resulted in keeping the appointment open until after July 1-59

Lt. Goodman, 503 Franklin Dr-Patuxent Pk, asked for letter stating if and when that road is built to SRC specifications the County will accept it for maintenance. Mr. Bond will inspect this road and advise what is needed to bring it up to SRC specifications.
