All Board members and their attorney were present at today's meeting.

Clerk was instructed to make no engagements for April 21, except the State Road which will be heard in the morning.

Mr. J. Julius Johnson, Dr. Jones and Dr. Paddock came to present a Certificate from the Dept of Agriculture showing that this County is free of Brucellosis and also free of TB except for $\frac{1}{2}\%$ of 5 herds in the County. Dairy farmers here plan to improve the herds yearly.

Board of Education appeared with the forms to be signed for the balance of the State School Loan of \$180,000.00 - \$175,000 is for 7th Dist elementary school and \$5000 for addition to Mechanicsville school

were sent to the State Tax Commission for selection one for Assessor's Aide.

Dr. Locke came in about unsightly roadways etc. Dr. Locke, Mr. Hodges and Mr. McCloud will meet on date selected at 1 pm at Daugherty's warehouse to plan for dump site in that area. Mr. Duke and Dr. Locke will visit the various schools to enlist the services of the pupils- there is to be an essay with a prize of 10 free admissions to the movies.

~~Robert~~ Taylor, owner of Compton dump site was authorized to maintain that dump for the price of \$20 per month-and rent of \$50 per year for the site, beginning May 1st. He was instructed to burn the dump only after 4 pm, and not at any time there is a heavy wind.

Mr. Wm. E. Vernstein of V & H Bakery, came in about a license to peddle ice cream from a truck- Mr. Sterling will contact the States Attorney to ascertain if it is necessary for Mr. Vernstein to pay \$300 for a license.

Committee appointed by the General Assembly to study assessments in the various Counties were here for several days, Messrs Morris Burgee, Gordon Kaid, Garner Duvall, Robt Ludwig and Walter Lindsey- visited farms etc here and conferred with the Supervisor of Assments and Tax Assessor on methods. A report from the committee will be received later, about November 1st, when the Commissioners and Assessor's staff will be invited to attend the meeting.

Letters were sent to Frank Combs, J. Frank Raley and John R. Drury to appear 10 a.m. April 21st to consider insurance for the county owned buildings.

J. Moakley Mattingly came in about the dump site in the 7th-altho abandoned people are still using it - Manor Rd school site now ready for use; (Carroll Sheehan road)

Mr. Bond was asked to bring Mr. Webb in for a meeting to discuss financing maintenance of county roads at 10:30 Tues- 4/21 The County has authority to borrow an additional \$50,00000 which could be used for maintenance and this could be paid monthly by using SRC funds.
