Lex. Pk. Ambulance Squad asked for the 59-60 a appropriation, granted also to Ridge Vol. Ambulance Squad \$700 each.

Hill's Trailer Court is paying property tax on all their trailers, do they also have to pay occupancy - Mr. Sterling says they do.

Deputy Stephen Pratt reports 4 Trailers owned by the Dove family - colored, at R 5 and Scotland, no sewage disposal arrangements there. Clerk requested to write D. Houser and have a proper inspection made as to health menace etc.

James Waring with Wm. Loker, Jr came in about the storm sewer in Patuxent Park - SRC had implied they would ask the Lex. Pk Vol Fire Dept to wash out the ~~sewer line~~ ^{storm drain} which it was thought was stopped up and causing the trouble. Excavation should be made to determine actually where the trouble lies, in storm sewer or ~~household disposal~~ ^{water disposal}. When Mr. Waring was asked if his company would pay expenses if trouble found to be in their sewer he agreed. Whatever is causing the trouble should be corrected by either County or owner.
