The Commissioners met in regular session today with all members, Administrative Asst and attorney present.

Mr. Dan Bowles and Mr. K.B. Duke came to discuss work in the office of the Supervisors of Election. Mr. Duke will come every Wednesday from 10 to noon for the purpose of furnishing information regarding dates of registration etc. News papers were advised of this with the note that these were **NOT DAYS FOR REGISTRATION**, that there is one day prior to the Primary election and two days prior to General Elec. and both dates will appear in the County newspapers. Mr. Duke will consider the amount of work involved in this extra work and inform the Board what he feels is commensurate pay.

Commissioner John M. Hodges is to attend the meeting with the Bd of Education on Wednesday-Sept 2.

Mr. Guy Willey, Piney Pt area reported ditches on his property closing up and need cleaning out. Mr. Willey advised Mr. Duncan of this condition by letter and it is possible Mr. Duncan may come down to check on this matter.

Mrs. Mary Calloway purchased a lot at Tax Sale but so far this land has not been located. Mr. Sterling will check into the matter.

Mrs. Raymond Raley answered letter sent her last week, she told the Bd that Col Davidson of Cremona has had the road leading to her home well repaired-he is very anxious that the bus come in as far as it did some time ago- the Bd is opposed to this since the road is a private road and not a County road and busses do not travel on private roads.

J. Douglas Bond, SRC, asked the Bd to have a letter written to Mr. Duncan asking for Fed aid & Secondary System for 9 inch gravel service and a bituminous surface treatment the three roads to receive this are Town Creek, Vista Rd and Robt. Stevens

Mr. James Waring came in during Mr. Bond's discussion about the sewage problem and complained of the line in Saratoga street-as soon as R/W has been secured a new 24 inch pipe will be laid there (Midway Dr. Franklin St-to Saratoga)
