Sen. Dorsey with Louis Hammett came in to ask for an increase in salary for Mr. Hammett from \$1600 to at least \$2,000.00, to be effective as soon as possible. Commissioners agreed to consider the request.

Mr. Robert King-Bd. of Education came in to ask that Allotment and Incentive fund checks be sent the Bd. of Education early this month- also asked for report on A-J to be sent to State Bd. of Education. The checks were sent to Bd. of Education office, but since there was a discrepancy between the amounts received in the Treasurer's office and the amount stated by State Bd. of Education as reported to them by the office of the Comptroller, Commissioners preferred to await Mr. Lipski's visit here and have him check same, before A-J report is sent

All money in the Special Roads Acct is to be deposited to the CGF #1 account, the following accounts are to become part of the CGF #1 account hereafter,

Commissioners will now have only CGF #1 and
