Water and Sewage for the Nursing Home


Mr. John Williams and Mr. Schull reviewed plans sent to the commissioners concerning this project. These gentlemen said they are meeting with the town commissioners today and would present a copy of these same plans to them. Mr. Guyther was called in and it was explained to him that there would be a sewer line from the nursing home crossing some privately owned property. Mr. Williams suggested getting an easement from Mr. Gough, the owner, so that if this had to be dug up for maintenance, it could be done.

Mr. Williams suggested a meeting between the town commissioners and the county commissioners to resolve how the cost for this would be divided. It is his opinion that the water line should be an 8 inch line and he highly recommends this. He also recommends giving a set of plans to the hospital for their study, as they are going to share in the cost.

It was suggested that Mr. Williams go ahead and prepare a bid proposal. He will talk this over with the town commissioners and the hospital and suggest having one member of each board meet with the commissioners.
