2021 General Assembly Session**

Leonardtown, MD – The Commissioners of St. Mary's County will hold a joint meeting with members of the St. Mary's County Legislative Delegation on October 6, 2020, at 6 p.m. The meeting will take place in the commissioners meeting room inside the Chesapeake Building, 41770 Baldrige Street in Leonardtown. The purpose of the meeting is to consider requests by the Commissioners of St. Mary's County, as well as proposals from organizations and citizens for the enactment of legislation during the 2021 session of the General Assembly of Maryland.
