**St. Mary's County to Rescind COVID-19 State of Emergency**

**LEONARDTOWN, MD** – Following Governor Larry Hogan's June 15 announcement that Maryland will lift all COVID-19 related emergency mandates and restrictions effective July 1, St. Mary's County Government will also rescind the local State of Emergency.
