LEONARDTOWN, MD – The Commissioners of St. Mary's County (CSMC) started the day with a joint meeting at the St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission (MetCom), which included updates and discussion on capital improvement projects, problem water and sewer areas, an EDU transfer program, and the EPA lead and copper rule. The CSMC wrapped the joint meeting by approving MetCom's FY2025 Capital Improvement Budget and FY2026-2030 Plan. The CSMC reconvened at the Chesapeake Building for the remainder of their [business meeting](#). They began with an invocation and the pledge, followed by approval of the consent agenda.

- [Approved](#) the Waterway Improvement Fund grant award for needed repairs to the pier at Piney Point Lighthouse Museum & Historic Park.
