## **July 15 Commissioner Meeting Rollup**

**LEONARDTOWN, MD** – The Commissioners of St. Mary's County (CSMC) began their business meeting with an invocation and the pledge, followed by approval of the consent agenda.

The CSMC then presented proclamations in recognition of <u>National Park and Recreation Month</u> and <u>Maryland Buy Local Week</u>.

For their main agenda items, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- <u>Approved</u> the proposed ordinance amendments to the Stewart's Grant Planned Unit Development.
- <u>Approved</u> the amendments to ZONE24-0413, specifically regarding the request to change the land use designation and zoning designation of properties in Great Mills which are part of the second phase of redevelopment of the Pax River Village Center.

During County Administrator Time, the Commissioners took the following action:

- Reviewed future CSMC meeting agendas.
- Approved the FY26 Victims of Crime Act Grant award.
- Approved the Adult Recovery Court Program and Family Recovery Court funding.
- Approved and accepted the Family Services Program award for the Circuit Court.
- Approved the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) grant award.
- <u>Approved</u> for the Department of Recreation and Parks to submit a solicitation for the management of employee childcare centers.

The CSMC wrapped their business meeting with **Commissioner Time**.

The next Commissioners meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 22, 2025, at 9 a.m., in the CSMC Meeting Room, on the 1st floor of the Chesapeake Building, located at 41770 Baldridge Street in Leonardtown.
