Update - Stanley Martin Withdrawal from St. Mary's 2050 Comprehensive Plan Consideration

LEONARDTOWN, MD – Stanley Martin Homes has [withdrawn its request to change the land use designation](#) for the Wildewood Preserve property. As a result, this application will not be included for consideration by the Commissioners of St. Mary's County and will not be subject to public comment during the public hearing for the St. Mary's 2050 Comprehensive Plan.

The public hearing will be conducted on **Tuesday, October 6, 2026, at 6:30 p.m.** in the **CSMC Meeting Room** of the Chesapeake Building located at 41770 Baldrige St. in Leonardtown. **Doors will open at 5:30 p.m.**, and sign-up sheets for those wishing to speak will be available in the lobby.
